

MIAA Ice Hockey Appeal Process For Schools Disqualified from Tournament Play for Exceeding the Misconduct Rule

A school that has requested and has been granted an appeal must apply the following procedure:

1. Issue in advance a \$300 non-refundable purchase order or school issued check made payable to the MIAA (this check may not be from a Boosters Club or personal account). These funds will be used to support the annual Ice Hockey Sportsmanship Awards sponsored by the MIAA, MSHCA and the Ice Hockey Committee.
2. Supply five(5) copies of the following to the Hearing Sub-committee:
 - a. Total of: misconducts, game misconducts and/or game disqualification penalties, including minor penalties for the entire season.
 - i. Game by game-numbered and dated with opponents, including opponent's penalties.
 - ii. Player number (include year of graduation).
 - iii. Bring copies of your game sheets to support your data.
 - b. If multiple misconducts or disqualifications occurred in one incident, a site manager's report or game official's report is required.
 - c. Include a letter signed by the superintendent, principal/school committee chair or designee and athletic director explaining why the Ice Hockey Committee should grant this request.
 - d. Include a statement from the coach explaining why this situation occurred.
 - e. Include a statement from the athletic director or principal indicating what steps have been taken during the season to address this situation.
 - f. Include a statement from the athletic director or principal indicating what steps you plan to take next year to prevent a re-occurrence.
 - g. The principal, athletic director and coach are required to attend the hearing.
